

RBI: Andrii Stepanenko to be the new RBI Management Board member in charge of Retail Banking

Vienna, 7 December 2017. In its meeting today, the Supervisory Board of Raiffeisen Bank International AG (RBI) decided that Andrii Stepanenko will take over the Management Board member position in charge of Retail Banking. Stepanenko will succeed Klemens Breuer, who left the bank at the end of October. Stepanenko was born on 28 April 1972 and until now was Deputy Chairman of the Management Board and in charge of Retail Banking at Raiffeisenbank in Russia. His appointment is still subject to the approval of the supervisory authorities.

Stepanenko, who holds a doctorate degree in Finance, began his career with the RBI Group in 1998 as Head of Corporate Credit Analysis at Raiffeisenbank Ukraine. From 2000 to 2003, he held a leading role for risk management development at the RZB Group in Vienna. Between 2007 and 2008, he held the Chief Risk Officer function at Raiffeisenbank in Russia and has held his current position since 2008.

RBI's Supervisory Board will decide on the replacement of the Board Member for the Markets division in the coming weeks.
